

General instructions

1. **Temperature in the cottage.** The standard temperature in the cottage is approximately 20–22 °C. When adjusting the underfloor heating, please note that it will take at least 12 hours before the selected temperature is reached. Also remember that drying clothes, gloves etc. on the radiators is prohibited as that causes a fire hazard.

2. **Hot water.** There is only a limited amount of hot water available, so please use it sparingly. In most cottages, water is heated during the night.

3. **Using the electric sauna.** When the electric sauna is on, some heating appliances may automatically switch off. For this reason, please switch the sauna heater off immediately after use, and note that it may not be possible to use all electric appliances at the same time. Adding fragrance oils or equivalent products to the sauna heater is prohibited. Do not dry your clothes in the sauna, as that causes a fire hazard.

4. **Dishwasher.** Dishwashing liquid used for hand washing the dishes must not be used for the dishwasher – use dishwasher detergents only. Rinse the dishes before placing them in the dishwasher. The dishwasher must not be opened while it is running. Turn on the water supply to the dishwasher before starting the machine.

5. **Washing machine.** Follow the washing machine's dosage instructions. Turn on the water supply to the washing machine before starting the wash cycle. Do not dry laundry over the radiators or in the sauna.

6. **Candles and open flames.** Candles and outdoor candles may only be burned on fireproof surfaces. The grill must be emptied and cleaned appropriately. Please ensure fire safety at all times.

7. **Smoking.** Smoking is strictly prohibited indoors.

8. **Windows and doors.** Please close all windows and doors after airing out the cottage on check out day.

9. **Furniture.** Please move furniture back to its original place if you have rearranged it.

10. **Rowboat.** Pull the rowboat to the beach after use, or otherwise attach it properly. Place the oars inside the boat. Bring the life jackets inside.

11. **Damages.** In the event that something was broken during your stay, please inform the person responsible for maintenance. Agree on compensation with the maintenance responsible before you check out.

12. **Final cleaning, towels and bed linen.** Please note that your booking does not include bed linen, towels or final cleaning, unless otherwise agreed and specifically stated in the booking confirmation. Beds must not be used without linen: please contact the person responsible for maintenance if you wish to rent bed linen. Turn off the lights, close the windows and lock the doors when you leave. Leave the settings for heating and ventilation as they were when you first arrived (please do not turn off the heating, because in the wintertime, for example, the cottage pipes may freeze if the heat is off). Please contact the person responsible for maintenance if you need any additional information regarding the cottage. In the event that appliances are broken due to misuse, the customer is liable for damage. Always ask, if you are unsure about how to use an appliance.
